CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

It was very difficult to get Shropshire Council to do anything, probably worse than last year.

Thanks to Tom Wall for project managing the work done on Whinberry Hill during the year. Grants had ensured that this was at very little cost to the Parish Council.

Footpath in Clunton. It was likely that Shropshire Council would contact the Parish Council with their decision in due course.

Faded white lines on the roads was the responsibility of Shropshire Council.

REPORT FROM SHROPSHIRE CLLR N HARTIN

The Shirehall site was considered surplus to requirements and the Council would move to another site in the town. The finances were very bad with a further £62m savings to be made this financial year. 300 full time equivalent jobs were to go. The Council was very close to bankruptcy. A further £810,000 was to go from the Highways budget. The North West relief road was still in the budget.

CLIMATE AND ENVIRONMENT GROUP

Advice was being sought from the AONB regarding natural flood management of the Clun.

Asulox for bracken spraying had been withdrawn from the market.

OPEN DISCUSSION

Diane Carey said that the road works in Clunton today were to deal with the flood water problem.
